## Fine Arts Department Guidelines

1. All General Information, Local and State Rules apply to the entire Fine Arts Department.
2. Exhibitor must be 18 years of age to enter in Adult Fine Art Divisions.
3. All entries must be the original work of the Artist and not previously shown at the San Bernardino County Fair.
4. The Chairperson and Fair Management reserve the right to refuse any picture that is not suitable to be shown due to the subject matter of the art.
5. Entry fees shall accompany the Still Entry Form. You may also enter on-line at [www.sbcfair.com](http://www.sbcfair.com). Choose your Division & Class carefully. Description must be the artists TITLE of exhibit / artwork.
6. The San Bernardino County Fair offers a *Theme Ribbon* to those artists that depict the theme in their art. Please indicate "THEME" on the entry form or on-line, if you wish to be considered for this award.  
The 2010 Fair Theme is "**Green Acres!**"
7. All artwork must be prepared for hanging with screw eye and taut picture wire. Artwork with clips or cardboard hangers will be rejected. Properly wired, unframed canvases will be accepted if no staples are showing. All paper entries must be framed under glass.
8. Painting *not thoroughly dry* will be rejected.
9. Hung art entries shall not exceed 45" in any direction.
10. Exhibits shall be properly labeled on a 3 x 5 card and taped to the back top right-hand corner of each entry (Sculpture – tape info card on bottom of piece) with the following information:
  - a. Exhibitor's name and phone number
  - b. "Title" of Exhibit
  - c. Division and Class numbers.
11. All artists that wish to demo during the fair must submit a resume and photos of their work. Please submit a request with your entry form.
12. Handicapable Division: learning or physically impaired exhibitors may be special education students or disabled citizens. Signature of a Parent or Guardian is required on the entry form. Ribbons will be awarded 1st through 3<sup>rd</sup>. **No cash awards. No entry fee. All subjects, all media in Division 202.**
13. Each artist may enter one of four divisions:
  - 200** – Amateur: a beginning student or an artist who is not selling their work. All college students are encouraged to enter individual or class artwork.
  - 201** – Professional: an artist who has sold a painting and/or is a teacher
  - 202** – Handicapable: a learning or physically impaired exhibitor
  - 203** – Sculpture: a three dimensional exhibit
14. Sale of Exhibits: The Fine Arts Department personnel are **not** permitted to make sales or accept monies for any artwork. Interested buyers may fill out an "interest form" which will be given to the Artist. The artist, in turn, can contact the interested buyer on their own.
