## 4-H & Open Youth Exhibits Guidelines

1. All previously noted General Information, Local and State Rules apply to the 4-H and Youth Department.
2. Open to all 4-H and junior residents of San Bernardino County and adjacent counties from the age of 3 years to 17 years depending on which youth group you enter your items with.
3. **Attention 4-H Members:** Policy adapted by the 4-H Program:
  - Fairs are open to primary members (4-H youth between ages 5 to 8 years) as long as their projects and participation is not competitively judged. The use of the Danish and American Systems of Judging are not acceptable for use with 5 – 8 year olds. Primary Members should only receive Participation recognition. Structured Competition is not appropriate for the 5 – 8 year olds.
4. Age range definitions are as follows: Youth 1 – preschool to 12 years, Youth 2 – 13 years to 17 years. Based on the age of the Exhibitor as of January 1, 2010.
5. Entry forms are available at the fair office, in the back of this Handbook and on-line at [www.sbcfair.com](http://www.sbcfair.com). Online registration is also recommended.
6. Forms may be photocopied.
7. Please put exhibitor name, division, class and description on each item for receiving day.
8. For group projects/class projects, use teacher or leaders name on entry form.
9. Exhibitors must check in with their entered items in the Youth Building. **No late entries will be accepted.**
10. No article may be entered in more than one class.
11. The exhibitor must prepare all entered items within one year prior to the opening date of the Fair, May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2010.
12. Entries in this Department do not entitle the Exhibitor free entry to the Fair.
13. The signature of an adult is required on the entry form.

### Floriculture Guidelines

- The exhibitor must grow all Floriculture entries either as an integral part of a vocational agriculture supervised program, 4-H project or as an Independent.
- Exhibits must be adequately and correctly labeled.
- All plants must be planted in a suitable nursery container.
- Plants must be clean and free of all dirt, cobwebs, lint, etc. All others will be disqualified.
- The Exhibitor must maintain plants.
- Plants exhibited in the flowering classes should have opened flowers.
- Plants in flats must be established in flat two (2) weeks prior to fair opening.
- Plants should be marketable size and condition.
- All plants must have “water catchers” – entries will be refused without them.

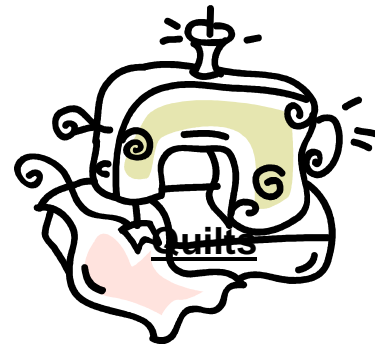

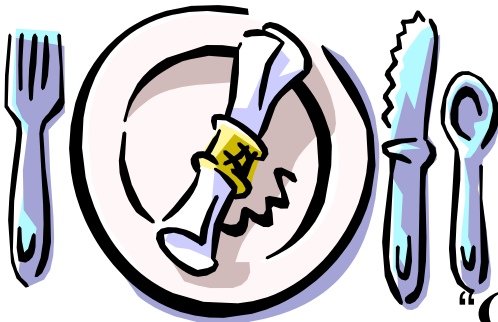
