Junior Fine Art Guidelines:

1. Exhibitor must be under the age of 18 as of December 31, 2009.
2. Please put **Exhibitor's Name, Age, Phone Number, School, Grade, Division & Class** on a 3X5 card taped to the back of your entry in the top right corner, (sculptures may put their card on the bottom of the sculpture).
3. If you would like to have your entry considered for the "**Fair Theme**" entry, please write the word **Theme** on the label.
4. Art exhibits limited per artist as follows:
 - a. 5 pieces of framed arts
 - b. 3 pieces of paper entries backed with construction paper, mat board or cardboard.
 - c. 3 sculptures

Class Projects:

Public School/Private School /Private Instructor Class Projects: Must have a minimum of 3 participants per project. Art must be secured on a background such as

mat board, cardboard or construction paper. Class projects will be displayed together. Each class project entry will receive a ribbon. No individual ribbons will be awarded. **Class Project entries must** have the *name of the exhibitor, school name, grade, teachers name and phone number* on **each** entry. Please include the words "**Class Project**" at the top of the entry form.

Display – Framing

1. All art must be ready to hang. The wire on the back of framed paintings must be taut with no wire showing above the frame.
2. **No stand picture frames or clips will be allowed.**
3. All framed paper (not canvas) paintings (watercolor, crayon, graphite, colored pencil, mixed media or acrylic on paper) must have acrylic plastic (plexi-glass) covering the painting. **Glass will be allowed only on pastel & charcoal paintings.**
4. No wet paint
5. Size limit: Entries shall not exceed 40" (including the frame) in any direction.
6. Original works only. *No pre-printed pages (i.e. coloring book pages)
*except class projects.

Fair Theme

If you are interested in having your entry listed as a "Fair Theme", please put the word "**Theme**" on your entry form and on the card on the back of your entry. Entries must depict the 2010 Fair Theme of "**Green Acres**"

Awards

1. All entries, preschool through 12 years of age, will receive either a 1st, 2nd or 3rd place ribbon.
2. For exhibitors 13 through 17, there will be one 1st place, one 2nd place and one 3rd place winner per division & class. All other entries will receive a participation ribbon only.
3. There will be a **Best of Division** ribbon for each division.
4. There will be a **Best of Class** ribbon awarded for each class.
5. There will be a **People's Choice Award**. Selected by public votes during the Fair.
6. **Sponsor Awards** will be given as listed in competition handbook.

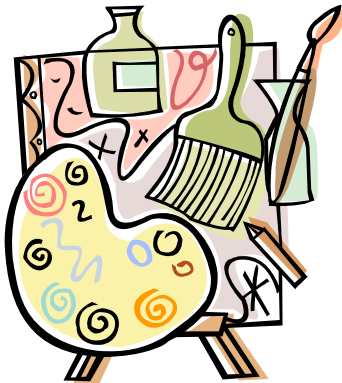
