Guidelines:

- Rules:** Definitions and judging procedures are prescribed in the latest edition of the Guide Book and Standard of the American Rabbit Breeder's Association, Inc. and shall apply to all district and county fair rabbit shows, provided they do not conflict with any of the State rules and regulations prescribed by the California Department of Food and Agriculture - Division of Fairs and Expositions.
- Eligibility:**
- Open Divisions:** Open to exhibitors 18 years of age or older who are residents of the United States.
- Youth Divisions:** Open to Youth Exhibitors, 5 - 17 years of age, who are residents of San Diego, Los Angeles, Orange, San Bernardino, Imperial, Ventura or Riverside Counties, unless otherwise stated. 4-H, Grange or FFA exhibitors are governed by 4-H/Grange/FFA eligibility and age rules, and must be residents of the above counties, unless otherwise stated. Indicate Age and 4H/Grange/FFA Club or Chapter on the entry form. NOTE: Youths 5 - 8 years of age are limited to special classes. Out of area youths may enter Open Divisions.
- Show Rabbits:** Only Rabbits entered in this Show will be allowed on the Fairgrounds. Exhibitors in violation will be asked to leave and entries will be forfeited.
- Rabbits must be identified by permanent ear markings conforming to the entry form on arrival at the show. Substitutions may be made within the same class, same variety and sex. Only substitutions will be accepted until 5:00 PM - Friday, May 14th only.
- Rabbits will be shown & judged in the proper division & class for breed, variety, age and sex only.

Any breed not listed will show in the all other divisions. Management reserves the right to combine divisions if any division has three exhibitors or less with less than five animals total in the division. Management reserves the right to add divisions if any breed has three exhibitors or more than five or more animals.

- A judge may excuse a rabbit from competition if it appears to be fatigued or out of condition, but the rabbit should be counted as an entry.
- Any rabbit showing evidence of disease will be immediately removed from the fairgrounds.
- Rabbit ID# MUST be indicated on Entry Form or entry will be returned and entry fee forfeited. Entry form must contain, breed, color and/or variety, age and sex.
- Premiums are paid in both Divisions.**

Rabbit Meat Pens

*Open to San Bernardino County Youth Only
9 years of age and older*

1. Entry consists of three rabbits all the same breed, any variety.
2. Three rabbits will count as one Rabbit Entry for this division only.
3. All Rabbits must be out of a doe owned by the Exhibitor. The exhibitor must own the birth-doe at least 90 days prior to the opening day of the fair.
4. Actual Date of Birth & each Rabbit Tattoo number must be shown on the Entry Form. Bill of Sale or statement verifying exhibitor as the breeder must be submitted at check-in.
5. Only Rabbit Meat Pens judged to be market and consumer ready (equivalent to Group 1 grade) will be eligible to compete in any and all Championships.
6. All Champion and Reserve Champion Meat Pens will be sold in the Junior Livestock Auction on Saturday, May 14th. Meat Pen Rabbits may not be entered in any other class.
7. At the San Bernardino Co. Fair, all Grange and Independent Rabbit Meat pens must have Five (5) Entries per class. If less than Five (5), Grange and Independent Rabbit Pens along with showmanship will compete in the 4-H Division.

Rabbit & Cavy Showmanship

1. Must be pre-entered and entry fees paid.
2. Enter class according exhibitor's age as of Jan 1, 2010.
3. Birth date must appear on Entry form.
4. Only rabbits and cavies owned, fitted and shown by the exhibitor in regular divisions are eligible.
5. Exhibitors shall be on hand and ready to exhibit at the time of judging. The rabbit and cavy showmanship contest shall precede the judging of the exhibits in that division.
6. Exhibitors must be in uniform as defined in rules at beginning of livestock section.
7. Parents are not allowed at judging table nor shall they interfere with the judging process.

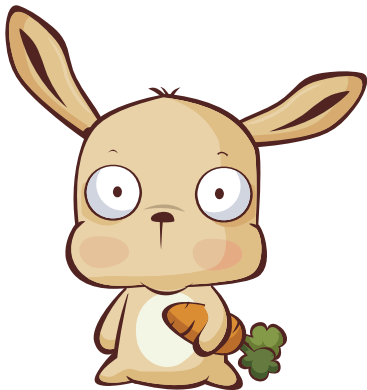
