- Judging shall be by comparison and in accordance with the latest published American Poultry Association Book of Standards. Decisions of the judges shall be final. Exhibitors or their agents will not be allowed to converse with the Judges while judging is in progress.
- Birds substituted must be same breed, variety, age and sex as the original entry.
- All crates must be removed from the showroom as soon as birds are transferred to show coops.
- **Any bird with lice, mites, fleas, arrives at the show diseased will be immediately removed from the fairgrounds by the exhibitor at the exhibitors expense.**

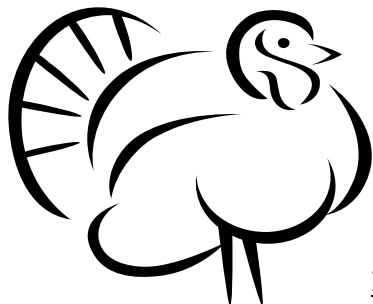

- Leg bands MUST identify all birds. Leg band ID must be indicated on entry form or entry will be rejected and entry fee forfeited. Duplicate numbers must not be used on birds of the same variety. Birds will not be accepted unless properly banded. Seamless bands are recommended, but Poultry bands will be accepted.
- Management is not responsible for errors on entry form - make sure you enter correct division and class.
- All exhibitors are required to feed and water their own birds upon arrival. Feed will be provided. Fair personnel will feed and care for birds their after.
- Decisions of the judges shall be final. Exhibitors or their agents will not be allowed to converse with the Judges while judging is in progress.
- Birds substituted must be same breed, variety, age and sex as the original entry.

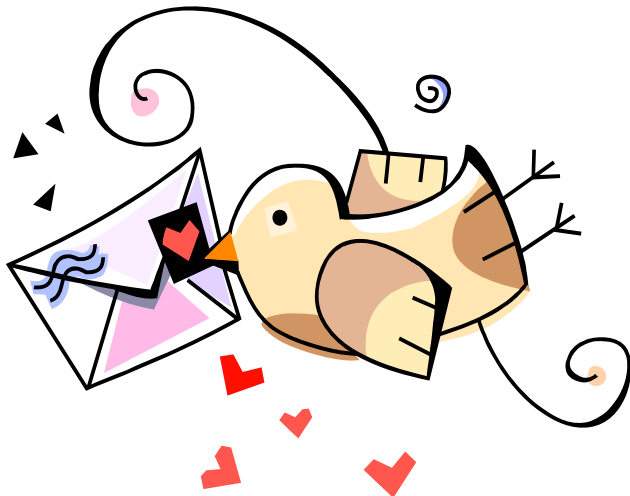

8. Exhibitors must provide water and feed cans for each cage on exhibit. All exhibitors are responsible for the care of their birds. Feed will be provided.
9. Only Poultry Meat Pens judged to be market and consumer ready (equivalent to Group 1 grade) will be eligible to compete in any and all Championships.
10. At the San Bernardino Co. Fair, all Grange and Independent Poultry Meat pens must have Five (5) Entries per class. If less than Five (5), Grange and Independent Poultry Pens along with showmanship will compete in the 4-H Division.
11. **Any bird with lice, mites, fleas, arrives at the show diseased will be immediately removed from the fairgrounds by the exhibitor at the exhibitors expense.**
12. **All meat birds will be weighed in at the time of inspection.**

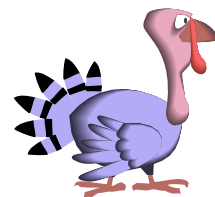
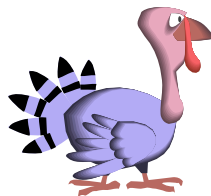

Market Poultry Guidelines and Rules:

1. One pen per exhibitor.
2. Pen is three birds **not** over nine weeks of age weighing between 3½ - 5 1/2 lbs each.
3. Birds must be Cornish Cross and identified on entry form by leg band numbers. Forms without ID numbers will be rejected and entry fees forfeited.
4. Sales receipt or Invoice needed at time of Check-In or birds will not be weighed.
5. Meat Pen consists of cockerels, pullet or a combination of both.
6. All Champion and Reserve Champions will be sold at the Junior Livestock Auction, Thursday, May 20, 2010.
7. Birds must be identified by leg bands attached at time of check-in. Numbers must correspond with numbers on entry form or birds will be rejected and entry fee forfeited.

5. Pre-Entry Required. Exhibitors shall be on hand and ready to exhibit at the time of judging. The poultry showmanship contest shall precede the judging of the exhibits in that division.
6. Exhibitors must be in uniform as defined in rules at beginning of livestock section.

We will offer two Master Showmanship Competitions in the Small Animal Show – one for seniors and one for juniors

The 1st place winner, of each of the Senior and Junior Classes, in each specie, will be given the opportunity to compete in the Master Showmanship Contest. Each specie contest winner must declare to the Livestock Office by 12 Noon on Saturday, May 22nd, his or her intentions of competitions.

Guidelines and Rules (Continued)

If their intentions are not declared the Livestock Office will offer the next placed specie contestant the opportunity to compete in the Master Showmanship Contest. In case of tie or difficulty in determining the top showmen, the judge may ask exhibitor questions regarding knowledge of breed, weights, origin, etc.
