### FFA & 4-H Horticultural Department

1. Divisions in this Department are restricted to members of FFA Chapters & 4-H Clubs of San Bernardino.
2. Set-up days & times: May 12, 11 am until 7 pm. May 13, 11am to 7pm, May 14, 9am-5 pm.
3. All exhibits must be in place by 5:00 pm May 14, 2010
4. Each patio design exhibit and landscape design exhibit must be complete in itself. Exhibitors must furnish their own superstructures and accessories.
5. All exhibits must be properly labeled (Scientific and common names) for educational value. Labeling to be on stand and shall be securely anchored. No identification of exhibitor and club or chapter will be allowed on exhibit prior to judging.
6. Exhibits must be built for the duration of the Fair to be eligible for premiums awards. Exhibits must be kept in fresh condition and each club or chapter is responsible for the care & maintenance of its exhibits. General watering & maintenance will be provided any special cars required shall be the responsible of the exhibitor'

### FFA & 4-H Horticultural Department (Cont.)

7. **Parents, advisor and other adults shall ADVISE ONLY and shall not participate in construction of any exhibit.** A responsible adult for each chapter or club must be present at all times during installation of design exhibits. Exhibitors found in violation will forfeit cash awards & entry Fee.
8. No chain saws permitted or electric shoves or rottillers.

## Horticultural

### Special Rules:

1. Size: Exhibit spaces will be 8' X 8" space..
2. All spaces will be outside, scattered around the Show Grounds.
3. No sales allowed. However exhibitors may promote/advertise their services, interests and/or products.
4. Each design exhibit and landscape design exhibit must be complete in itself. Exhibitors must finish their own superstructures and accessories. There will be limited amount of space with electricity available. Note on entry form it is required. Cords used to distribute power to electrical apparatus shall be rated 15 AMPS minimum and contain ground wire. Cords not meeting these requirements will not be permitted. The Fair will provide barriers to prevent access into exhibits.
5. All exhibits must be properly labeled (Scientific & Common names) for educational value. Labeling to be on a stand and shall be securely anchored. No identification of exhibitor, club or chapter will be allowed on exhibit prior to judging.
6. Exhibits must be built for the duration of the Fair. Exhibits must be kept in fresh condition and each in responsible for the care & maintenance of their exhibits.
7. No chain saws, electric shovels or roto tillers permitted.
