Due to some unethical practices by some of our 2007 San Bernardino County Fair Livestock Auction exhibitors, it has become necessary to write the unspoken rule. If you choose to enter into the 2010 San Bernardino County Fair Livestock Auction, you are choosing to sell your animal to the highest bidder. You are also accepting the fact your animal will be terminated at the place chosen by the winning bidder.

The Livestock Buyers are very important to the Livestock program, and is a wonderful source for helping our children attend college and further their education. They are important and should always be treated with respect.

Therefore, at no time should an exhibitor approach a prospective buyer and ask them to purchase your animal and then return the animal to you. This type of action is unethical, and offensive to our prospective buyers, and harms the program as a whole.

Any exhibitor found practicing unethical behavior will be penalized.

Let's all work together to continue to strengthen and improve the long-standing livestock traditions.
